Multi-currency Cash Passport – Promotion Terms & Conditions of Entry (“Conditions of Entry”)

1. The promoter is MasterCard Prepaid Management Services (NZ) Ltd (“Promoter”) of Level 3, MasterCard House, 136 Customs Street West, Auckland New Zealand.

The Cash Passport is valid for up to five (5) years but inactivity fees may apply after twelve (12) months of non-usage of the Cash Passport. The total residual fund of the Cash Passport may be withdrawn at any time and will incur a fee depending on the country of activity.
10. Should an Eligible Entrant's contact details change during this promotion, it is the Eligible Entrant's responsibility to immediately notify the Promoter. A request to modify any information provided in an entry should be directed to the Promoter.
